# Subject: NTA Declares the Result/NTA Scores of Common University Entrance Test (UG) – 2025 – reg.

The National Testing Agency has been entrusted by the Ministry of Education and University Grants Commission (UGC) to conduct the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) for admission into Undergraduate Programmes in Central Universities under the Ministry of Education, and other participating Universities/ Institutions/ Organizations/ Autonomous Colleges for the Academic session 2025-2026.

2. The CUET (UG) provided a single window opportunity to students seeking admission in any of the Central Universities (CUs) or other participating organizations (including State Universities, Deemed and Private Universities) across the Country especially those from rural and other remote areas, to help establish better connections with the Universities. A single Examination enabled the Candidates to cover a wide outreach and be part of the admissions process to various Central Universities and other participating Universities.

3. The National Testing Agency conducted the Common University Entrance Test (UG) - 2025 [CUET (UG) – 2025] in computer-based test (CBT) mode for 13,54,699 (Thirteen lakh fifty four thousand six hundred and ninety nine) unique registered candidates. These candidates applied for various combinations of subjects for the academic session 2025-2026.

4. The CUET (UG) - 2025 was conducted for admission in the academic session 2025-26 in CBT mode as per the following details:

5. The CUET (UG) – 2025 provided access and flexibility in the following ways:

- In total, 37 subjects (13 languages, 23 domain-specific subjects, 01 General Aptitude Test) were offered to the candidates in the CUET (UG)-2025. Candidates could choose up to a maximum of five (05) subjects, including languages and the General Aptitude Test.
- 322 unique question papers and 1059 total question papers, including 13 languages (total 57,940 questions), were administered over a period of 19 days in 35 shifts.
- The medium of the question paper was in 13 following languages English, Hindi, Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, and Urdu.

 The CUET (UG) - 2025 was conducted in 300 exam cities, including 15 cities outside the country in Abu Dhabi, Doha, Dubai, Munich, Kathmandu, Kuala Lumpur, Kuwait City, Lagos, Manama, Muscat, Riyadh, Sharjah, Singapore, West Java, and Washington.

6. The role of NTA is confined to the registration of candidates, conduct of the test, hosting of answer keys, inviting challenges, finalizing answer keys, preparing and declaring results, and hosting the score card. A merit list will be prepared by participating Universities/organizations. Universities will decide about their individual counselling based on the score card of CUET (UG) - 2025 provided by NTA.
