2. This proforma is applicable only if ExSM candidate's age is 35 years and above as on the date of medical fitness test. If the age is less than 35 years, the proforma as per Annexure-VI of the CEN No. 05/2024 is applicable.
3. Shortlisted ExSM for CBAT should produce the Certificate in original at the time of entry for CBAT, failing which they will not be permitted to appear in the CBAT
4. Candidates are advised to refer only to the official websites of RRBs for latest updates on the recruitment process. Please do not be misled by unauthenticated sources.
5. Beware of touts who try to misguide candidates with fake promises of appointment for jobs on illegal consideration. RRB selections are based on Computer Based Test (CBT) and recruitment is based only on the merit of the candidates.
